

# Pacific Coast Horse Shows 2006 Hunter Jumper Series Specifications

## Hunter Classes

**Walk Trot:** Open to all Junior and Amateur riders of all ages. Judged at the walk & trot. Rider may not enter any other classes except Walk Trot classes.

**Crossrail Hunters:** Junior & Amateur riders of all ages. Horses are shown over fences 1'6", may be performed at a trot or canter. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. May not cross enter into 2'3" or higher.

**Short Stirrup Hunters & Equitation:** Riders 12 & under. To show over jumps 2'0" (w/o oxers). Simple lead changes will not be penalized. May not cross enter into divisions with fences 2'6" or higher or Pony Hunters.

**Long Stirrup Hunters & Equitation:** Junior riders 13-17 and Amateurs 18 & over. Same specifications as Short Stirrup.

**Green Rider Hunters:** Open to all Junior and Amateur riders in their 1<sup>st</sup> year of showing over fences. Fences 2'3". May not cross enter into divisions with fences 2'9" and over.

**Baby Green Hunters:** To jump fences 2'6". Open to horses that have not shown over fences 2'9" or higher prior to the current show season.

**Pre Green Hunters:** To jump fences 2'9"-3'. Open to horses that have not shown over fences 3'3" or higher prior to current show year.

**Pony Hunters:** Riders 17 & under. Open to all ponies. Small/Medium ponies 2'-2'3". Large ponies 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into 3'3" or higher.

**Low Children/Adult Amateur Hunters:** Open to Junior and Amateurs of all ages. Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter any classes 3'0" or higher.

**Children/Adult Amateur Hunters:** Open to Juniors and Amateurs of all ages. Fences 2'9". Riders may not cross enter any classes 3'3" or higher.

**Modified Junior/Amateur Hunters:** To jump fences 3'. Open to all junior & amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into any division with fences 3'6" or higher.

**Low Hunters:** To jump fences 3'. Open to all horses & riders. Horses may not cross enter into Baby Green Hunters.

**Leadline:** Handler must be 18 & over.

## Medal Classes

Riders must be a member of GSDHJA to ride in the GSDHJA Medal classes.

In all medals, at least three riders must enter and be judged to award the medals. 2<sup>nd</sup> – 10th receives ribbons.

**PCHS 2' Medal:** All entries must jump a medal type course of fences 2' including at least 2 changes of direction. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. A work off is at the judges discretion. Riders may not cross enter into classes with fences 2'6" or higher.

**GSDHJA Green Rider Medal:** All entries must jump a medal type course of fences 2'3" including at least 2 changes of direction. A work off is at judges discretion. Except for the Finals, riders may cross enter the GSDHJA Mini Medal at the same show. Riders competing at 2'6" may only enter Green Rider Medal if they are in their first season of showing 2'6".

**GSDHJA Mini Medal:** All entries to jump a medal type course of fences 2'6". Course will incorporate 2 standard tests (tests #1-7), and include at least 2 changes of directions. No additional testing or work off is necessary.

**GSDHJA Flat Medal :** All entries will work collectively on the flat and will be asked to demonstrate at least six advanced flatwork skills such as: length-ening and/or collection of stride, counter canter, turn on the haunches, turn on the forehand, work without irons and/or other deemed appropriate by the judge.

## Jumper Classes

**Schooling/Open:** Open to all horses & riders. Fences can be 2', 2'3"-2'6", or 3'. Horses can not cross enter in between the schooling classes.

**Low Children's/Adult Amateur:** Open to Junior riders & Amateur riders. Fences 2'3"-2'6". May not cross enter 3'3" or higher.

**Children's/Adult Amateur:** Open to Juniors 12-17 & Amateurs of all ages. Fences 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into 3'6" or higher.

Table rules are located in the Jumper section of USEF rule book.

## Equitation & Pleasure on the Flat

**Maiden:** Horse or Rider that has never won a blue ribbon in that class at any SCHC, GSDHJA, OCHSA, or PCHS show.

**Novice:** Horse or Rider that has never won three or more blue ribbons in that class at any SCHC, GSDHJA, OCHSA, or PCHS show.

**Limit:** Horse or Rider that has never won six or more blue ribbons at any SCHC, GSDHJA, OCHSA, or PCHS show.

**Open Equitation over Fences:** Open to all Junior & Amateur riders. 11 & Under: 2'3", 12-13: 2'6", 14 & Over: 2'9".

## Awards

All classes will be placed to 10<sup>th</sup> place. First place receives a \$10 *Petsmart* gift card, except in medal classes.

**Points: Regular classes:** 1<sup>st</sup>=10pts. 2<sup>nd</sup>=6pts. 3<sup>rd</sup>=4pts. 4<sup>th</sup>=2pts. 5<sup>th</sup>=1pt. 6<sup>th</sup>=1/2pt.

**PCHS Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes at their discretion. It requires three horses for the class to run. If a single or 2 horse class does run, a prize is not awarded.**
